



Gatineau River Tour, August 25, 2024

See the Gatineau Hills with the Gatineau River cutting through them just north of Ottawa.

We will start below Wakefield and row about 14 km to an island just north of the Quebec Hydro dam at Chelsea. We round the island and return to the Community Centre. Forests, hills, old cottages, a yacht club, and a golf club line the route. After derigging and loading the boats, we will enjoy refreshments at a patio at Wakefield.

N.B.: This is a replacement tour for the Canadian Sculling Marathon (CSM); so there is no need to rush your rowing. (The CSM will celebrate 20 years in late August, 2025.)

Date: Sunday, August 25; meet at 9h00 at the Farm Point Community Centre.

Level: the distance is approximately 28 km, so this is a distance challenge and intermediate level sculling is required.

Please note: Bring your own water, snacks, and weather appropriate gear. We are planning to have a meal after the event at a restaurant in Wakefield.
