

A Day in the Thousand Islands

Sunday June 23



Start your day at **Grass Creek Park**, east of Kingston, on the Bateau Channel. Row between Howe Island (originally named Ka-ou-enesegoan by local Iroquois) and the mainland on the way to the Admiralty Islands just off Gananoque. Visit **Half Moon Bay** on Bostwick Island where boaters have been going for almost a century of non-denominational services. Lunch at Rotary Park in **Gananoque**, site of a battle during the War of 1812, before continuing past the granite 'arch' of the Frontenac Biosphere on the way to Ivy Lea. This day will involve water launching and landing.
